

# INTRODUCING TUMATO MULTIPURPOSE THEME

When we started designing Tumato, we made sure it suits all the professions. Tumato is a multipurpose responsive HTML5, CSS3 theme built on the well-known Twitter Bootstrap front-end framework. The theme has simple and clean design which comes with filterable portfolio and contact form along with Google map.

Tumato comes with predefined layouts and an attractive unique full width responsive Homepage design.

## CUSTOMIZING TUMATO

### Changing the Color Scheme of the Theme

We wanted to make Tumato very easy for customization. We wanted the web designers to customize and play around the theme with as minimum changes as possible.

For example, consider you want color variations for the theme. You can change the entire theme color variation by adding suitable hex code or color code to style.LESS css property. It changes the entire color combination of the whole theme.

Open style.LESS using your favorite text editor like notepad and replace your custom color code in the css property *@theme-color*. Consider changing the theme color to orange scheme, just modify the property as shown below

```
@theme-color: orange;
```

### Adding More Columns to the Theme

Tumato uses Bootstrap Framework which supports adding up to 12 columns.

Featured boxes on the homepage can be customized to increase or decrease the number of boxes present.

We have used HTML comments throughout the theme which will help you find the right code easily.

Consider adding one more Featured box to the homepage,

1. Find the `<!--featured-boxes-->` HTML comment in the index.html page.
2. Change the existing `col-sm-4` to `col-sm-3`
3. Now copy any one of the Featured box HTML code between `<!--featured-box start-->` and `<!--featured-box end-->`
4. Paste the copied HTML code inside `row` div and make sure that the `row` div uses `col-sm-3` class.
5. That's it, save the file and refresh the browser to see the change.

## HOW TO ADD CONTENT TO TUMATO HTML TEMPLATE?

---

### HOME PAGE

- **How to change the logo?**

To change the logo, go to “resource” subfolder, open logo.psd file using Photoshop, edit the same as per your requirements and save it as logo.png in the “images” folder. If you already have the logo in png format then just replace it with logo.png in “images” folder, make sure it is 200px width and 100px height.

- **How to change the existing menu in the navigation?**

Open the index.html with any text editor and scroll down to <!--navigation--> html comment, under <ul> tag you will find <li> tags which contains menus, here you can change the menu name as well as the link of it. For example if you wish to change “Our Services” menu to “Our Products” then the HTML code would be `<li><a href="products.html">Our Products</a></li>`

- **How to add the new menu to the navigation?**

Open the index.html with text editor and scroll down to <!--navigation--> html comment, under <ul> copy the existing <li> tag line and paste it where you wish to add the new menu within <ul> tag. Rename the menu by replacing the text left to </a> tag and change the link of the menu by replacing the existing text from href tag. For example if you wish to add “Our Works” menu to the navigation then the HTML code is as follows-

```
<li><a href="ourworks.html"> Our Works </a></li>
```

- **How to add your text in the text rotator on the homepage?**

Open the index.html with text editor and scroll down to <!--text-rotator--> html comment in the `<span class="textrotator">` add

your text separated by comma to rotate one after another.

- **How to change icons from the featured box on the homepage?**

Open the index.html with text editor and scroll down to `<!--featured-boxes-->` html comment, under `<div class="featured-box-home">` you will find icon tag something like `<i class="fa fa-desktop fa-2x"></i>`, in this tag you have to replace icon code. For example if you want to replace monitor icon from homepage then replace “fa-desktop” with “fa-tree”.

Tumato uses fontawesome icons which are free to use, visit <http://fontawesome.io/icons> copy the icon code and just replace with the icon code from template.

- **How to add your Social Media links in the footer?**

You can add your social media links in the footer. Open the index.html with text editor and scroll down to `<!--social media icons-->` html comment. Under `<ul>` `<li>` add your social media links inside `href=""` followed by Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and Google plus respectively.

Just do it once on the homepage and replace footers from all the pages with the modified one.

- **How to change the background slider?**

Background slider plays an important role in the theme, currently we have used 3 wallpapers from <http://www.wallpaperswide.com> for demo purpose. Just replace slider-1.jpg, slider-2.jpg and slider-3.jpg from “images” sub folder. Make sure you use the image of at-least 1366 X 768 pixels.

- **How to add new image to the background slider?**

You can also add new background slider to the template, open the index.html with text editor and scroll down to `<!--background-slider-->` html comment. Under `<ul>` add the following html line-

```
<li><a></a></li>
```

and add slider-4.jpg image to “images” folder.

- **Adding Favicon to the theme**

Go to “images” subfolder and replace your favicon with the existing PNG image. Make sure it is in PNG format with the name favicon.

## ABOUT US

- **How to add your photographs in about us page?**

To add your photographs, go to “resource” subfolder, open avatar.psd file using Photoshop, now add your image and trim it using lasso tool and save it as snap-1.png in the “images/aboutus” folder. Follow the same steps for rest of the images.

## OUR SERVICES

- **How to change icons of our services page?**

Open the services.html with text editor and scroll down to <!--services--> html comment, under `<div class="featured-box-services">` you will find icon tag something like `<i class="fa fa-desktop fa-2x"></i>`, in this tag you have to replace icon code. For example if you want to replace monitor icon from homepage then replace "fa-desktop" with "fa-tree".

Tumato uses fontawesome icons which are free to use, visit <http://fontawesome.io/icons> copy the icon code and just replace with the icon code from template.

- **How to add/remove services on services page?**

Open the services.html with text editor and scroll down to <!--services--> html comment, Copy the existing service html code from <!--service start--> till <!--service end--> and paste it before <!--row end--> line. Change the service heading, text and icons as per your needs.

## OUR PORTFOLIO

- **How to change the image, title, description and button link of portfolio?**

Portfolio images are saved in “images/portfolio” folder. Just replace these jpg images with your images, make sure images are 800px width and 600px in height.

To change the title and description of the portfolio, open the portfolio.html with text editor and you will find <h3> and <p> tags inside <!--portfolio item start--> and <!--portfolio item end-->, replace existing text from <h3> and <p> tags to change title and description respectively.

Below <p> tag you will find <a> tag which has href="#", replace # with your link to change the button link.

- **How to add new item to portfolio?**

Open the portfolio.html with text editor and scroll down to <!-- portfolio --> html comment, Copy the existing portfolio html code from <!--portfolio item start--> to <!--portfolio item end--> and paste it before <!--row end--> line. Change the portfolio heading, description and button link as per your needs. Once you are done with this, change the portfolio item filter tag by modifying data-value="". For example if you want to add portfolio item with “birds” tag then it is data-value="birds" and add the following “birds” button code inside portfolioFilter div.

```
<a href="#" data-value="birds" class="current"><input type="button"
class="btn btn-default" value="Birds" /></a>
```

## CONTACT US

- **How to get emails from Contact Form?**

Tumato HTML Template comes up with working contact, to receive the form content to your email- open mailer.php with any text editor such as

notepad, find for example@example.com and replace with your own email ID where you want to receive the form content.

- **How to add your location in Google map?**

Go to <https://maps.google.com>, search for your location and click on settings icon at the bottom right corner, click on share and embed map menu, now click on “Embed map” tab and copy the entire iframe code.

Open the contact.html with text editor and scroll down to <!--Google map code--> html comment, replace the <iframe> line with copied one. Make sure iframe width is 100% and the height is 550px.
